On Saturday, September 19th from 10AM until 12PM, Alameda Reads, a program of the Alameda Free Library, will be hosting our second annual Walk-A-Mile For Literacy. This family oriented event will act as both a fundraiser for our Adult Literacy program and as a means to raise awareness of literacy issues in Alameda. The purpose of the event is to encourage our community to "walk a mile" in the shoes of an adult with low literacy skills.

The walk will begin at the Alameda Free Library and will proceed along Park Street. There will be several stops, our official "Literacy Awareness Stations", at local businesses where displays will convey the challenges that our students and 30 million other American adults with low-literacy skills encounter every single day - like reading a menu, filling out a job application, and receiving information about health care. The event will end at the library with refreshments and raffle prizes.
